Thank you for all the work you do for our communities in these difficult times. Adjusting to the challenges of social distancing by relying on technology has been a significant challenge for many of us. On behalf of Congresswoman DelBene, I write to share information about the Distance Learning and Telemedicine (DLT) Loan and Grant Program offered through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

The purpose of the DLT Loan and Grant Program is to encourage and improve telemedicine services and distance learning services in rural areas through the use of telecommunications, computer networks, and related advanced technologies by students, teachers, medical professionals, and rural residents. The maximum grant award is \$1 million per project and the application deadline is July 13, 2020. Please review the attached resources to determine whether your project is eligible for this opportunity, and feel free to share this information with anyone who may be interested. We encourage all who are eligible to apply.
